COVID-19 READINESS PROCEDURES AND GUIDELINES

RiverDogs Staffing During Camps

- All Staff required to wear face mask when interacting with campers and their parents
- Gloves are mandatory when handling food
- Counselor-to-Camper Ratio: 1 to 10

Camp Drills and Stations

- 4 groups of 10 campers each
- There will be limited interacting between different teams throughout the camp by having 2 groups in the corners of the outfield, another in the infield dirt and the final in the cage (separated, covered locations planned during rain situations)
- By doing this we will ensure that each individual team/group will be social distancing from one another
- Hand sanitizer will always be present at all four of our stations

Drop Offs

- Parents and non-essential staff are encouraged not to enter the facility during camps
- We have staff members greet parents at sign in table with 6 foot tape on the ground when dropping kids off for camp
- Sign in pens will be wiped down after each use

Campers Cleanliness

- No sharing snacks, water bottles and baseball equipment
- If a camper exhibits COVID-19 symptoms
- On-site medical technician will examine the camper, including a temperature check
- Parents will be notified and child will be picked up if he/she has a fever
- Children with existing respiratory or asthmatic conditions are discouraged from attending
